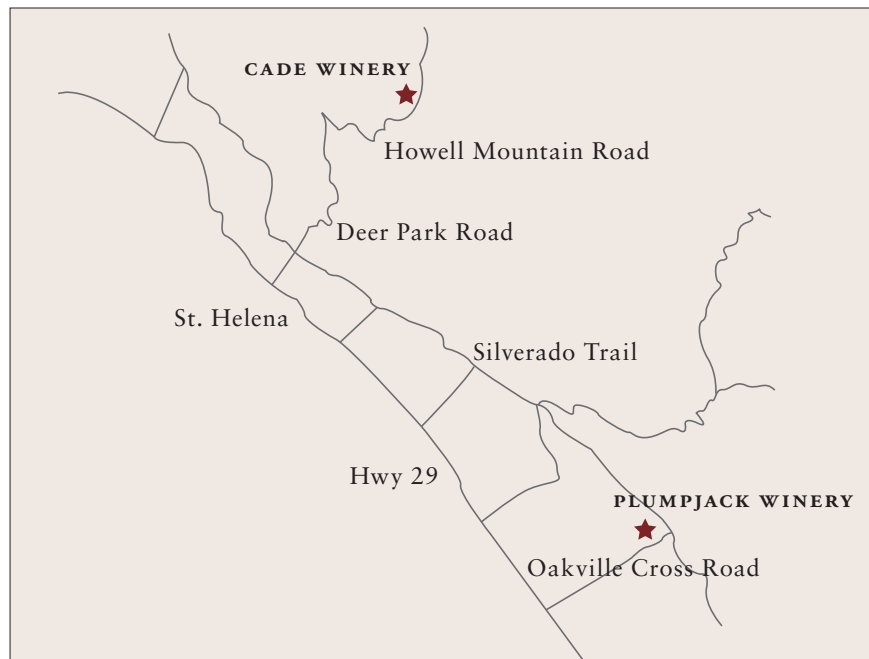




THINK GREEN. DRINK GREEN.

Purchased in 2005, CADE Estate was built upon the belief to produce world class wines representative of our Howell Mountain Estate using the latest in green technology. Once complete, CADE will be recognized as a green building, as we are currently on track to become LEED GOLD Certified.



DIRECTIONS FROM PLUMPJACK WINERY:

Make a left onto Oakville Cross Road. When Oakville Cross Road ends, turn left on Silverado Trail. Head North on Silverado Trail for 8.2 miles where you will intersect with Deer Park Road. Make a right on Deer Park Road and travel for 4.5 miles, where Deer Park Road turns into Howell Mountain Road. Continue on Howell Mountain Road for one more mile. CADE is located at 360 Howell Mountain Road South, on the left.

DIRECTIONS FROM DOWNTOWN NAPA:

From downtown Napa, head north on Highway 29. Continue on Highway 29 approximately 17 miles through Yountville, Oakville and St. Helena. Just past downtown St. Helena, turn right at Deer Park Road and drive 4.5 miles, where Deer Park Road turns into Howell Mountain Road. Continue on Howell Mountain Road for one more mile. CADE is located at 360 Howell Mountain Road South, on the left.
